Managing Better is hosted by Care & Repair agencies across Wales, to ensure that barriers to independent living and increased dependency on acute NHS services are addressed. Our five-way service collaboration has combined experience, knowledge and skills, to focus on making the lives of some of Wales' most vulnerable older people easier to manage.

What does the Managing Better service offer?

We can help older people live in homes that meet their individual needs by offering the following:

- A home visiting service that assesses the home and identifies risks to independence
- Assessing Welfare Benefit entitlement and support to access the unclaimed funds
- Identifies hazards that might lead to a fall or accident and help to avoid them
- Professionally manage building work to high standards
- Offer advice and information relevant to prudent healthcare, winter-planning, falls prevention and health resilience
- Provide information and advice around new technology and assist, where it is safe and appropriate, to access the technology to support independence
- Referral to partner agencies and other organisations

Why you need the Managing Better service?

Our services are readily available in the community for older people 50+, to help support reablement and independent living, specialising in helping:

- People who have a sensory loss
- People living with dementia
- People who have survived a stroke

We are often the eyes and ears in the homes of vulnerable older people, providing support after they have left a hospital bed or NHS clinic.
