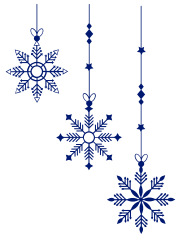

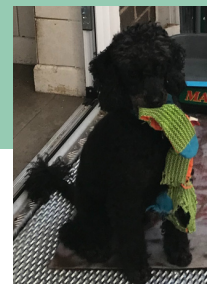

Our dedicated and trusted caseworkers can visit you and provide FREE advice and practical support to help you live as independently as possible.



We will listen to your needs and suggest a package of support which could include:

- minor adaptations to reduce the risk of falls at home,
- helping you obtain quotations from reliable builders to carry out repairs to your property,
- referring on to our Technical Service or an Occupational Therapist for larger works and adaptations,
- advice and help to make applications to other sources of funding, whenever possible, and
- advice about welfare benefits

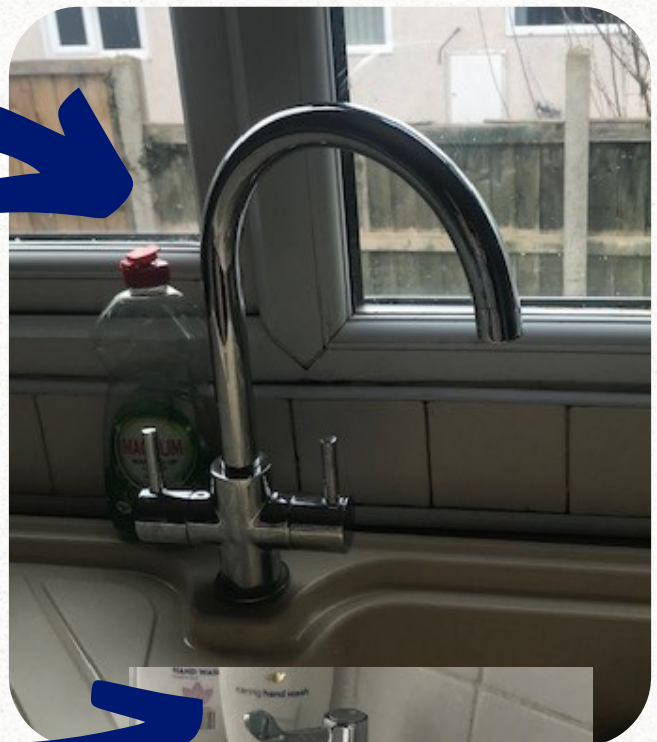
